Ordinance No. 220 (New Series)  
City of Blue Earth

An Ordinance Annexing Certain Real Estate to The City of  
Blue Earth, Minnesota

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Blue Earth as  
Follows:

Section I.

The following described real estate located in the County of Faribault and State of Minnesota, to-wit:

All that part of the Southwest Quarter of Section Seven (7) in Township One Hundred Two (102), Range Twenty-seven (27) West of the Fifth Principal Meridian that lies South of the right of way of the Chicago & Northwestern Railway Company as said right of way is now located, except tract deeded to Northern Natural Gas Co., a corporation, by deed on record in Book 118 of Deeds at page 440 in the office of the Register of Deeds in Faribault County, Minnesota, and all that part of the Northeast Quarter of Section Eighteen (18) in Township One Hundred Two (102), Range Twenty-seven (27) West of the Fifth Principal Meridian that lies West of the Blue Earth River and is included in the right of way of Minnesota Trunk Highway Number 16.

hereby is annexed to the City of Blue Earth, a municipal corporation, in Faribault County, Minnesota and shall after the effective date of this ordinance be included in the corporate limits of said City.

Section II.

It is found by the City Council of the City of Blue Earth that annexation is in the best interests of said City and of the territory being annexed under this ordinance.

Section III.

It is further found that the petition for said annexation has been filed in the manner provided by law and that no objections thereto have been filed.

Section IV.

It is further provided herein that the City Clerk of the City of Blue Earth shall file copies of this ordinance after publication with the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota, with the Municipal Commission of the State of Minnesota and with the County Auditor of the County of Faribault.

Section V.

This ordinance shall be effective from and after its passage and publication as required by law.
