IN THE MATTER OF THE PETITION AND RESOLUTION FOR THE  
DETACHMENT OF LAND FROM THE CITY OF BRAINERD

ORDER

The Minnesota Municipal Commission received a petition for the detachment of land from the City of Brainerd, Minnesota, on the 19th day of July, 1967, by the owners. A resolution for the detachment of the same land was filed by the City of Brainerd.

The territory involved consists of the following:

The South 660 feet of that part of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 36, T 45 North, Range 31 West, lying East of the right-of-way for Trunk Highway No. 371, described as follows:


Beginning at the Southeast corner of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ; thence West along the South line of said SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  to the center line of Trunk Highway No. 371; thence North along the center line of said trunk highway 660 feet; thence East parallel with the south line of said SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  to the East line of said SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ; thence South 660 feet, more or less, to the South line of SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  to the point of beginning; containing less than 5 acres

The property is adjacent to the City of Brainerd and said lands are unplatted and used exclusively for agricultural purposes. The petition is in proper legal form and sets forth the information required in Minn. Stat. 41A.06 and upon the files and records, the Minnesota Municipal Commission being fully advised in the premises,

IT IS ORDERED: That the foregoing described real property be, and the same hereby is, detached from the City of Brainerd, and made a part of the Township of Crow Wing, the same as if it had originally been made a part thereof.
