WHEREAS, the "Miss American Teen-Ager" contest is of wide local civic interest and importance and is a stimulant to cooperative association among the people of this community in a public-spirited endeavor,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold LeVander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim August 25, 1967, as

"MISS MINNESOTA TEEN-AGER DAY"
