PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the United States Navy plays a major role in the defense of this country and, indeed, of the free world, and
WHEREAS, the United States Navy is supplemented by the Naval Reserve Forces, and
WHEREAS, members of the Navy and Naval Reserve are our neighbors, our sons, our brothers and our daughters, and
WHEREAS, the Naval Sea Cadet is a civilian volunteer in the Naval Sea Cadet Corps, trained in the ways of the sea by civilian Naval Sea Cadet officers, and
WHEREAS, the Naval Sea Cadet Corps is a civilian youth volunteer program federally chartered by Congress on September 10, 1962, and
WHEREAS, the Naval Sea Cadet Corps is jointly sponsored by the United States Navy and the Navy League of the United States, and
WHEREAS, it is not only appropriate but also desirable that the admirable record and progress of the Naval Sea Cadet Corps be properly acknowledged.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold Lavander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of September 10, 1967, as

"NAVAL SEA CADET CORPS WEEK"

in Minnesota, and urge people to participate in this meaningful program that will be held to commemorate Naval Sea Cadet Corps Week to render proper tribute to the Naval Sea Cadet Corps and to accord recognition to individual members of the Naval Sea Cadet Corps for their patriotic tribute to our country.
