

PROCLAMATION


- WHEREAS, the President of the United States has proclaimed the week of October 8-14, 1967, as Fire Prevention Week, and
- WHEREAS, the people of Minnesota are vitally concerned with the protection of life and property from fire, and
- WHEREAS, last year fires in Minnesota caused the death of 93 persons and injured 312 and resulted in property damage of \$24,534,500.00, and
- WHEREAS, experience has shown that effective community fire prevention programs can save lives and property and preserve our resources,


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold Levander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of October 8 - 14, 1967, as

"FIRE PREVENTION WEEK"

in Minnesota, and urge all State and local government officials to join with fire departments, schools, civic groups and public information agencies in promoting programs to eliminate this careless waste of life and property.
