
Dear Mr. Foley:

ORDINANCE # 68

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE
LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF COLOGNE,
MINNESOTA TO INCLUDE LANDS OWNED BY
THE VILLAGE

Section 1. - A resolution having been passed by the
Governing body of the Village of Cologne,
Minnesota on December 26, 1964, to have certain lands
described therein and owned by the Village, included within the
Village of Cologne, Minn., which said lands are situated in
Carver County, Minnesota, and are described as follows, to-wit:

The South half of the Northeast Quarter
The Northwest Quarter of the Northeast
Quarter and Government Lot 1, of Section
14, Township 115 Range 25, excepting how-
ever, the following parcels or tracts of
land, to-wit:

First Exception - The tracts heretofore conveyed to the
Hastings and Dakota Railway Company
and to the Chicago, Milwaukee and St. Paul Railway Company, for
right of way.

Second Exception - The parcels heretofore taken and conveyed
to the State of Minnesota for Highway purposes/

Third Exception - A strip of land one rod wide along the South
line of said entire quarter section for
road purposes.

Fourth Exception - Beginning at a point on the East line of
said Northeast Quarter of Said Section 14,
said point being distant 440.2 feet, more or less, northerly from
the Southeast corner of said Quarter; and also being the point
of intersection of said East line with the Northerly right of way
line of U.S. Highway #212, as existing at the present time.
Thence continuing Northerly and along said East line, a distance
of 300 feet; thence Westerly at right angles to said East line a
distance of 201.0 feet; thence deflecting to the left at an angle
of 100°15' and extending Southerly to the said Northerly right
of way line of U.S. Highway #212; thence deflecting to the left
and Northeasterly along the said Northerly right of way line to
point of beginning.

Fifth Exception - Beginning at a point on the East line of the
Northeast Quarter of said Section 14, said
point being 959.06 feet Northerly from the Southeast corner of
said Quarter; thence continuing Northerly and along said East
line a distance of 352.0 feet; thence deflecting to the left at
an angle of 102°26' a distance of 315.0 feet; thence deflecting
to the left, at an angle of 98°23' a distance of 260.0 feet; thence
Easterly to the point of beginning,

Section 2. - The quantity of lands embraced within the
foregoing description, and bounded as
described, is approximately 7.5 acres.

Section 3. - The Village Council hereby determines (1) that the annexation will be to the best interest of the Village of Cologne, Minn., and of the territory affected; (2) that the territory described hereinabove, abutts upon the Village and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to Village government (3) that the land is not included within the boundaries of any other incorporated municipality and (4) that such territory wholly owned by the Village of Cologne, Minn.,

Section 4. - Therefore, the Village of Cologne Minn., hereby ordains and declares that the property hereinbefore described be and the same is hereby annexed to and included in the Village of Cologne, Minnesota, as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

Section 5. - This ordinance shall be final and take effect and be in force from and after filing certified copies thereof, with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, The County Auditor, and the Secretary of State, and from and after its passage and publication.
