FINDINGS OF FACT CONCLUSIONS OF LAW, ORDER

Secretary of State

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A Petition having been filed with the Minnesota Water Resources Board asking for the withdrawal of land from the Coon Creek Watershed District; and

The said Petition having been executed by the Board of Managers of Coon Creek Watershed District and by the two owners of the real estate here involved, all notices having been waived; and

The Minnesota Water Resources Board having read and considered said Petition dated April 7, 1967 at a Board meeting on July 13, 1967, and being fully advised in the premises, hereby makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Order:

## FINDINGS OF FACT,

I. That a description of said land is as follows, to wit:

The Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section One (1), Township Thirty One North (31N), Range Twenty Three West (23W) in the Village of Blaine, Minnesota.

II. That the land set forth in the Petition heretofore referred to has not received nor will said land receive benefits from the operation of Coon Creek Watershed District.

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III. That the Coon Creek Watershed District can perform the function for which it was established without the inclusion of the said land.

IV. That the said land is not a part of the Coon Creek Watershed.

## CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

V. That the Petition dated April 7, 1967, and heretofore referred to confers jurisdiction in said matter upon the Minnesota Water Resources Board.

VI. That said land has not and will not receive any benefit from the operation of the Coon Creek Watershed District.

VII. That the Coon Creek Watershed District can perform the functions for which it was established without inclusion of said land.

VIII. That said land is not a part of the Coon Creek Watershed.

## It is Therefore Ordered

IX. That subject to the requirement of law concerning indebtedness and levies, the following described land is hereby withdrawn from the Coon Creek Watershed District, and said land is described as follows:
