That one vote was cast against.


There being a majority for separation of the village, and said Village of Hazel Run being declared a separate Election and assessment District.

Reference is made to your letter of the 27th instant, in relation to the proposed amendment to the Constitution of the United States, which provides for the election of members of the House of Representatives by the people.

The proposed amendment is as follows: "The House of Representatives shall be composed of members chosen every second year by the people of the several States; and the electors in each State shall have the qualifications requisite for electors of the most numerous branch of the State Legislature."
