ly made up of patents, plate matter and advertisements; has been circulated at and near its  
said place of publication to the extent of 240 copies regularly delivered to paying subscribers;  
has been entered as second class mail matter in local post office of its said place of pub-  
lication; that there has been on file in the office of the County Auditor of said county the  
affidavit of a person having first hand knowledge of the facts constituting its qualifications as  
a newspaper for publication of legal notices; and that its publishers have complied with all  
demands of said County Auditor for proofs of its said qualification. A copy of each issue has  
been filed with the State Historical Society, St. Paul.
