W. E. STONE, being duly sworn, on oath says; that he is, and during all the times herein stated has been the publisher of the newspaper known as THE STAPLES WORLD, and has full knowledge of the facts hereinafter stated; that

for more than one year prior to the publication therein of the Ordinance No. 101.22 (Village of Motley, Minnesota)

hereinafter described, said newspaper was printed and published in the city of Staples in the county of Todd, State of Minnesota, on Thursday of each week; that during all said time said newspaper has been printed in the English language from its known office of publication within the city from which it purports to be issued as above stated in column and sheet form equivalent in space to at least four pages, with five columns to a page, each sixteen inches long; has been issued Thursday each week from a known office established in said place of publication and equipped with skilled workmen and the necessary material for preparing and printing the same; that in its makeup not less than twenty-five per cent of its news columns have been devoted to local news of interest to the community it purports to serve; that it has not wholly duplicated any other publication, and has not been entirely made up of patents, plate matter and advertisements; that it has been circulated in and near its said place of publication to the extent of at least two hundred and forty (240) copies regularly delivered to paying subscribers and had entry as second class matter in its local post office; and that there has been on file in the office of the County Auditor of Todd County, Minnesota, the affidavit of a person having knowledge of the facts, showing the name and location of said newspaper and the existence of the conditions constituting its qualifications as a legal newspaper.

That the Ordinance No. 101.22 (Village of Motley, Minnesota)

hereto attached was cut from the columns of said newspaper, and was printed and published therein in the English language, once each week, for 1 successive weeks; that it was first so published on Thursday the 17th day of August 1967, ~~and thereafter on Thursday of each week~~

~~including the 19th day of August, 1967, and that the following is a printed copy of the lower case alphabet from A to Z, both inclusive, and is hereby acknowledged as being the size and kind of type used in the composition and publication of said notice, to-wit:~~
