ORDINANCE NO. 14

AN ORDINANCE SETTING THE TIME FOR THE
HOLDING OF VILLAGE ELECTIONS IN THE
VILLAGE OF LONGVILLE, MINNESOTA

The Village Council of the Village of Longville, Minnesota, does hereby
ordain as follows:

Section 1: The regular village election for the Village of Longville,
Minnesota, shall be held on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in
November of each year.

Section 2: This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and
after the adoption and publication and the filing of proof thereof in the office
of the village clerk, as required by law.
