WHEREAS, The Secretary of the Treasury has made an urgent appeal for additional subscriptions to the Fourth Liberty Loan; and,

WHEREAS, Minnesota, one of the richest states in the Union, is in a position to do still more in the purchase of bonds; and,

WHEREAS, This is the opportune time to show that our people are anxious to back up our men at the front and secure from our enemies an unconditional surrender;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, J. A. A. Burnquist, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby join in the appeal of said Secretary of the Treasury and most strongly urge all of our citizens to oversubscribe this state's allotment of the Fourth Liberty Loan to the greatest extent possible.
