KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, DOUGLAS M. HEAD, Attorney General of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of authority vested in me by statute, and particularly by authority of Minnesota Statutes, Section 8.06, have constituted and appointed

of Stillwater, Minnesota, as Special Counsel to act for the Water Pollution Control Commission and the Minnesota Pollution Control Agency for the purpose of representing the Agency in the Matter of the Appeal of the North Suburban Sanitary Sewer District from Certain Classifications and Standards Adopted by the Water Pollution Control Commission for the Mississippi River. He shall be compensated on a reasonable fee basis, which shall include all clerical and other necessary office expenses incurred by counsel, together with necessary travel expenses; and that said compensation is to be paid from the funds of the Minnesota Pollution Control Agency upon verified claims therefor presented to said Agency by the appointee. This appointment shall be effective July 1, 1967. Said Special Counsel shall serve at the pleasure of the Attorney General or until the matter hereinbefore mentioned is completed.
