ORDINANCE NO. 138

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ANNEXATION TO THE VILLAGE OF WALKER, MINNESOTA, OF A PORTION OF GOVERNMENT LOT 2 OF SECTION 23, TOWNSHIP 142, RANGE 31.

WHEREAS, a petition has been presented to the Village Council of the Village of Walker, Minnesota, signed by a majority of the owners in number of the following described premises, in Cass County, Minnesota, to-wit: the North 264 feet of that part of Government Lot Two (2) of Section Twenty-three (23), Township One hundred forty-two (142), Range Thirty-one (31), lying between Garden Street and Factory Street, asking that said premises be annexed to the Village of Walker, Minnesota; and,

WHEREAS, copies of said petition have been filed with the Municipal Commission, the County Board, and the Town Board of Shingobee Township, as required by law; and,

WHEREAS, more than 30 days' posted notice of the hearing on said proposed annexation has been made by posting in three conspicuous places in the village of Walker, Minnesota; and,

WHEREAS, it appears to the satisfaction of said village council that said tract is less than 200 acres in area; that it abuts upon the village limits of said village, is urban in character, and properly the subject of village government, and that said petition was signed by a majority of the owners in number of said tract; and,

WHEREAS, the village council deems it to the best interests of said village and of the territory affected that said territory be annexed to said village; and,

WHEREAS, the said village council has by resolution duly passed, decided to grant said petition:

NOW, THEREFORE, the village council of Walker, Minnesota, does ordain as follows:

Section 1: The following described lands abutting upon the corporate limits of said village and not exceeding 200 acres in area and not included in any other village or any other city or borough, said tract being described as follows, to-wit: The north 264 feet of that part of Government Lot Two (2) of Section Twenty-three (23), Township one hundred forty-two (142), Range Thirty-one (31), lying between Garden Street and Factory Street, be and the same is hereby annexed to, included within, and made a part of the incorporated Village of Walker, Minnesota.

Section 2: This ordinance shall be in force from and after the passage and publication and the filing of certified copies thereof in the office of the Secretary of State, County Auditor and Municipal Commission.
