PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, innovation is the main-spring of the free enterprise system, and
WHEREAS, the fullest utilization of human resources is in the broadest public interest of the State, Nation and its citizens, and
WHEREAS, numerous people, due to personal needs, have not been able to participate as active, full-time members of the work forces and thereby contributes to the State's and Nation's progress, and
WHEREAS, Robert B. Miller helped pioneer the temporary help services industry in 1947 through founding of Employers Overload Company, a Minnesota corporation, and
WHEREAS, that company has expanded to now include branches throughout the Nation and in Canada, and
WHEREAS, that company now provides employment for some 30,000 people in widely diversified occupations on temporary assignments, as well as a permanent staff of more than 250 men and women,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold Lavender, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby commend Employers Overload Company on its 20th Anniversary, and its founder-President, Robert B. Miller, and extend to them on behalf of the people of Minnesota our appreciation and respect for past contributions to the progress of Minnesota and our warmest wishes for a most successful future.
