PROCLAMATION

- WHEREAS, the active participation of individual homeowners is of singular importance to the President's program to beautify America, and
- WHEREAS, the American homeowner's interest in American beautification must be kept at its highest interest throughout the year to take full advantage of all available natural beauty, and
- WHEREAS, the planting of townscapes, landscapes, and individual home grounds must be a continuing endeavor at proper seasons, and
- WHEREAS, fall is the ideal time for creating a greater number of and more colorful spring gardens through planting lawns, shrubs, trees, and flower bulbs,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold LeVander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of October 1-7, 1967, as

"SPRING GARDEN PLANTING WEEK"

in Minnesota, and invite the citizens in all communities throughout the State to join in the observance of such week with appropriate ceremonies and activities.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this twenty-eighth day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty-seven, and of the State, the one hundred tenth.
