ORDINANCE, CHAPTER XVI - FORM OF GOVERNMENT*

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING OPTIONAL PLAN A AS FORM OF GOVERNMENT FOR VILLAGE OF SARTELL.
WHEREAS the question of "Shall Optional Plan A, Modifying the Standard Plan of Village Government by providing for the election of a fourth councilman and for the appointment by the Council of the Clerk and Treasurer be adopted for the government of the Village of Sartell" was submitted to the voters at a special election held in August, 1967; and,

WHEREAS the voters of said municipality, at said special election, did by majority vote, approve the adoption of Optional Plan A Form of Government for the Village of Sartell, NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE OF SARTELL AS FOLLOWS:

Section 160.01

That the Village of Sartell hereby adopts Optional Plan A, Modifying the Standard Plan of Village Government by providing for the election of a fourth councilman and the appointment by the Council of the Clerk and Treasurer as provided for in Chapter 289 of Minnesota Laws of 1967, Section 412.551.

Adopted by the Council of the Village of Sartell, this 2nd day of October 1967.
