Dear Superintendent Higgins:

In accordance with Laws of 1965, Chapter 901, Section 87, the State of Minnesota Bureau of Criminal Apprehension is designated as the state agency to receive funds from the Federal Bureau of Investigation, United States Department of Justice. These funds are reimbursement for monthly charges on teletype equipment tying in directly with the Federal Bureau of Investigation in Washington, D. C. and for such initial installation charge as necessary.

Such reimbursement funds shall be received and handled in accordance with Subdivision 3 of 4.07 of the Minnesota Statutes.
