

VILLAGE ORDINANCE NUMBER 18 OF THE VILLAGE OF BROWNTON:

Ordinance to annex to the village of Brownton, lots number one to fourteen inclusive, of Zanders Re-Arrangement of Shillings Second Addition to Lake Addie.

The Village council of the Village of Brownton do ordain as follows:-

Section I. Whereas, Joseph H. Zander, Henry Wisdorf and Carl Maas, being all of the voters resident upon and all of the owners of lots one to fourteen inclusive, of Zanders Re-Arrangement of Shillings Second Addition to Lake Addie, have filed with us a petition asking that all of said lots be annexed to and made a part of the village of Brownton:

Now Therefore, It is Hereby ordained and declared that all of said territory be annexed to and is made a part of the village of Brownton, as effectually as if it had been originally a part thereof.

Section II. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the official newspaper of said village and upon the filing of a certified copy thereof with the county Auditor of McLeod County, Minnesota and also with the Secretary of State of the state of Minnesota.
