

PROCLAMATION

- WHEREAS, a basic freedom in our American life is to select an occupation of our own choosing, to develop our talents, our productive and economic potentials to the utmost, and
- WHEREAS, profound social, economic and technological changes in our society rapidly are changing the structure of occupations and industries, so that most individuals will need to make one or more occupational changes in their lifetimes, and
- WHEREAS, the Congress of the United States has recognized these problems and acted upon them through appropriate legislation, and
- WHEREAS, professional vocational guidance makes a maximum contribution to the process whereby an individual develops purpose and direction in his life's work and provides vital assistance to individuals in selecting, locating and training for job and career opportunities which benefit the individual and strengthen our society,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold LeVander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of October 22-28, 1967, as

"VOCATIONAL GUIDANCE WEEK"

in Minnesota, and urge all citizens to observe the week by making themselves better acquainted with the services offered by professional counselors and the extent to which each citizen can benefit from these services.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this eleventh day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty-seven, and of the State, the one hundred tenth.
