

**ORDINANCE NO. 29.**

**An Ordinance Extending the Boundaries of the Village of Houston, Houston County, Minnesota.**

**THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF HOUSTON, HOUSTON COUNTY, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**

Section I. The boundaries of the Village of Houston are hereby extended so as to include the parcel of land abutting said Village described as follows: Commencing at a point thirty eight feet south and twenty feet east of the southeast corner of lot 6, block 33, Mons Anderson's Addition to the village of Houston, Minn., thence south thirty six rods, thence west one thousand sixty feet, thence north thirty six rods to the south side of the street of said Mons Anderson's Addition, thence east on the south side of said street one thousand sixty feet to place of beginning.

Section II. The parcel of land described in Section I hereof is hereby declared to be a part of said Village, for all Village purposes, and shall hereafter be subject to the jurisdiction, laws and ordinances, now or hereafter in force in said Village, in like manner as the territory heretofore embraced in the corporate limits of said Village.

Section III. The tract of land as described in Section I hereof is hereby designated as Frank O. Abrahamson's Addition to the Village of Houston.

Section IV. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication and the filing of a certified copy thereof with the Secretary of State.



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
