Discontinuance of Trains Nos. 11 and 14 and Change of Service of Train No. 28 Between St. Paul, Minn. and Fargo, N.Dak.; and Northern Pacific Railway Co. Discontinuance of Trains Nos. 11 and 12 Between Little Falls and International Falls, Minn..

He shall be compensated on a reasonable fee basis to be paid from the funds of the Railroad and Warehouse Commission. Said Special Assistant Attorney General shall serve until December 15, 1967, or until this appointment, at the pleasure of the Attorney General, is earlier revoked.
