PROCLAMATION

- WHEREAS, Outreach Community Center is a private, non-profit service organization, established to provide comprehensive programs for mentally retarded adults, without regard to race, creed, or national origin; and
- WHEREAS, it tries to intergrate the mentally retarded back into the community vocationally, socially, and recreationally, and
- WHEREAS, it is believed to be the only facility of this type in the United States which provides both housing and training for the mentally retarded,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold LeVander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Wednesday, November 8, 1967, as

"OUTREACH COMMUNITY CENTER RECOGNITION DAY"

in Minnesota, and invite and encourage all citizens to learn more about this needed and worthwhile organization.
