PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, The Hennepin Minneapolis Knights of Columbus Council #435 has as part of its activity a youth organization called "Knights of Columbus Youth Organization", and

WHEREAS, The Knights of Columbus Youth Organization program encompasses fifty Catholic parishes and its goal is to bring boys and girls closer to the activities of their own parish church, and

WHEREAS, today there are over 34,000 Catholic children participating in the program and has filled a need for many years of children who would otherwise not belong to any activity or group, and

WHEREAS, the profits of the Star-studded premiere ice show of Holiday on Ice scheduled for Tuesday, November 28th, 1967, will go directly to and only for the Knights of Columbus Youth Organization,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold Lavander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Tuesday, November 28, 1967, as

"FRIENDS OF KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS YOUTH ORGANIZATION NIGHT"

in Minnesota, and urge all citizens to observe this date accordingly.
