PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, business and civic leaders of the City of Minneapolis have taken far-sighted and important action in creating The Nicollet Mall in Downtown Minneapolis, and

WHEREAS, the Nicollet Mall will provide pleasure and aesthetic satisfaction to the citizens of Minneapolis and Minnesota, and will attract many visitors to the state, and

WHEREAS, the Nicollet Mall is inspiring businessmen and governmental officials in many other cities in Minnesota to consider construction of similar center-city beautification projects, and

WHEREAS, the Nicollet Mall will be dedicated on November 20, 1967,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold LeVander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Monday, November 20, 1967, as

"NICOLLET MALL DAY"

in Minnesota, and request all citizens and visitors to the state to recognize it during this celebration.
