PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the Mobile Home industry has provided an accepted and popular mode of living as highlighted by the fact that in 1966--one out of five new housing starts was a mobile home, and

WHEREAS, these units are favored by all ages of people from the newly married couple to the retired folks, who find these completely furnished homes adequate, attractive, and at a cost within their budget, and

WHEREAS, there are over three hundred Mobile Home parks within our state, with a large number of new and completely modern parks in the process of being designed, or under construction, and

WHEREAS, many parks are equipped with ample recreation areas, community center buildings--well supervised, and all in compliance with local and state health regulations,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold LeVander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of December 1-8, 1967, as

"MOBILE HOME WEEK"

in Minnesota, and urge all citizens to observe this week as a tribute to the Mobile Home industry and the way of living they provide for our people.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this twenty-second day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty-seven, and of the State, the one hundred tenth.
