edge of the facts herein stated; that he is now, and during all the times herein stated has
been, the President of the Free Press Company, a corporation, organized and existing
under the laws of the State of Minnesota, and that said Free Press Company, a corporation,
now is, and during all the times herein stated has been the owner, publisher and printer
in charge of The Mankato Free Press, a daily newspaper issued from and printed and
published in the City of Mankato, County of Blue Earth, State of Minnesota, that the

up of patents, plate matter and advertisements;

(5) Circulated in and near its said place of publication to the extent of
at least two hundred and forty copies regularly delivered to paying subscribers
and has entry as second class matter in its local post office;

(6) Duly qualified as a medium of official and legal publication.

That there is on file in the office of the County Auditor of said Blue Earth
County an affidavit by the publisher and printer in charge of the said news-
paper, who had knowledge of the facts, showing the name and location of said
newspaper and the existence of the conditions constituting its qualifications as
a legal newspaper; and that the following is a printed copy of the upper and
lower case alphabet from a to z, both inclusive, and is hereby acknowledged
as being of the size and kind of type used in the composition, printing and

publication of said notice
