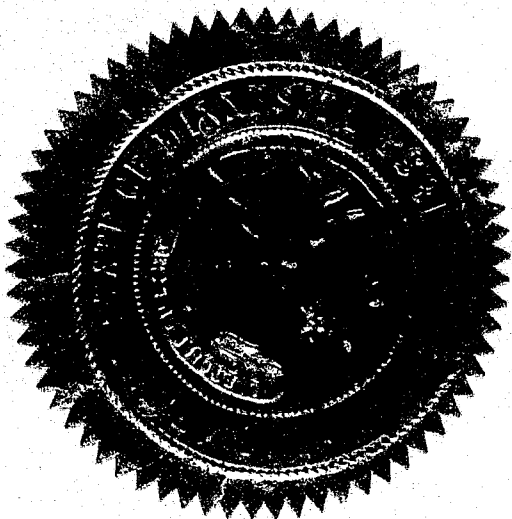


WRIT AND PROCLAMATION OF  
SPECIAL ELECTION TO FILL A VACANCY  
IN THE OFFICE OF STATE SENATOR IN  
AND FOR THE THIRTY-FOURTH SENATORIAL  
DISTRICT OF THE STATE.

A vacancy having arisen in the office of state senator in and for the Thirty-fourth Senatorial District of the State of Minnesota, by reason of the death of the incumbent thereof, Carl L. Wallace, on the 13th day of January, 1919;

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of the authority vested in me as Governor of the State of Minnesota, under Section 17 of Article 4 of the Constitution of the state, and pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 5 Session Laws of Minnesota, 1919, I, as such Governor, do hereby direct that a special election be held in the Thirty-fourth Senatorial District aforesaid on the 18th day of February, 1919, to fill the vacancy existing in the office aforesaid, candidates to be nominated and such election to be held, and all things pertaining thereto to be done, as provided under the provisions of Chapter 5 aforesaid.
