Reposing especial trust and confidence in your prudence, integrity and ability I have appointed you the said JOHN P. BADALICH, AS DIRECTOR OF THE MINNESOTA POLLUTION CONTROL AGENCY, FOR A TERM EFFECTIVE NOVEMBER 1, 1967, AND EXPIRING THE FIRST MONDAY IN JANUARY, 1971, PURSUANT TO THE LAWS OF MINNESOTA, 1967, CHAPTER 882.
