I, A. H. Stroschein, Clerk of the Village of Ormsby, Martin and Watonwan Counties, Minnesota, do hereby certify that at a special election held on the 14th of November 1967, in the Village of Ormsby, Minnesota, there was submitted to the electors the following question:


"Shall Optional Plan A modifying the standard plan of village government by providing for the appointment by the council of the clerk, treasurer and assessor and the election of an additional trustee, be adopted for the government of the village?"

and which said election resulted in a vote by the electors as follows:


37 votes for said question
18 votes against said question.
