WHEREAS, the Lions Club of Saint Cloud, Minnesota, has resolved for this Christmas season of 1967 to achieve the display of a Christmas Wreath on every residence and household in their community, and

WHEREAS, good citizens of Saint Cloud will join in the citywide display, not only as a unique civic demonstration, but will simultaneously contribute funds to support the extensive program of special education and assistance for the visually-handicapped in Saint Cloud, and
