AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF MARSHALL TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNPLATTED IAND NOT EXCEEDING TWO HUNDRED ACRES.

The Common Council of the City of Marshall do ordain as follows:

Section 1. A petition has been filed with the Common Council of the City of Marshall, Minnesota by the sole owner of the following described real estate in the County of Lyon, State of Minnesota, to have such land included within the City of Marshall, Minnesota:

All that part of the West Half (W2) of Section 33, Township 112 North, Range 41 West of the Fifth Principal Meridian described as follows: Beginning at a point which is the intersection of north-south quarter line of said Section 33 and the northwesterly right-of-way line of the former Willmar and Sioux Falls Railroad, now Great Northern Railway Company, constructed and maintained through said Section 33; thence south along said quarter line to a point on the center line of the main line track of said Railroad; thence southwesterly along said center line of said Railroad to a point on the north right-of-way line of the Redwood River Diversion Channel located and constructed through said Section 33; thence westerly along said Diversion Channel rightof-way to a point on the northwesterly right-of-way line of said Railroad; thence along said Railroad right-of-way line to point of beginning.

Section 2. The quantity of land embraced within the foregoing description, and bounded and described, is 54.8 acres, more or less.

Section 3. The Common Council hereby determines (1) that the annexation will be to the best interests of the City of Marshall, Minnesota and of the territory affected; and (2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the City and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to City government.

Section h. Therefore, the City of Marshall, Minnesota hereby ordains and declares that the property hereinbefore described be and the same is hereby annexed to, and included in, the City of Marshall, Minnesota, as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

Section 5. This ordinance shall be final and shall take effect and be in force from and after filing certified copy thereof with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the County Auditor and the Secretary of State, and from and after its passage and publication.
