**ORDINANCE NO. 122  
AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TERRITORY AND EXTENDING CITY LIMITS.**

The City Council of the City of Dawson, Minnesota does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. That it is hereby found and determined that the tract of land situated in Lac qui Parle County, Minnesota, described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at the southeast corner of the Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>) of Section Twenty (20), in Township One Hundred Seventeen North (17 N), of Range Forty-Three West (43 W), running thence north along the forty line 419 feet; thence West 330 feet; thence South 419 feet to the south line of said forty, thence East 330 feet to the point of beginning.

abuts the westerly city limits of the City of Dawson and is so situated and conditioned as to be the proper subject of urban government, and that it is to the best interests of the City of Dawson and of said above described territory that it be annexed to the City of Dawson for all governmental purposes.

Section 2. That it is also hereby found and determined that the petition of all of the owners of the above described territory praying for such annexation, was duly filed with the City of Dawson, the Town of Riverside, and the County of Lac qui Parle, on August 25, 1967, and with Minnesota Municipal Commission on August 28, 1967, pursuant to the provisions of Section 414.03 Minnesota Statutes Annotated and that no objections thereto have been presented or filed.

Section 3. That the said owners of said territory have executed and tendered to the City of Dawson their deed of easement for estreat purposes over that part of said tract described as follows:

Commencing at the southeast corner of the SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of Section 20, Township 17 N., Range 43 W.,

running along the east line of said forty a distance of two hundred nineteen (219) feet to a point of beginning; running thence west on and as a westward extension of the south line of Pine Street in the City of Dawson a distance of three hundred thirty (330) feet; running thence north sixty (60) feet; running thence east on and as a westward extension of the north line of Pine Street and a distance of three hundred (300) feet; running thence north and parallel to the east line of said forty a distance of one hundred forty (140) feet; running thence east thirty (30) feet to the east line of said forty, and running thence south two hundred (200) feet to the point of beginning.

which said easements are hereby accepted as extensions of and additions to existing city streets abutting thereon.

Section 4. That all of said tract described in Section 1 hereof is hereby annexed to the City of Dawson for all governmental purposes and that the city limits of the City of Dawson are hereby extended and enlarged to include the same, and that all thereof is hereby zoned as residential property, and is assigned and made a part of the Third Ward of the City of Dawson.

Section 5. That this ordinance shall be in effect from and after final passage and publication, and that true and correct copies hereof shall be forwarded to and filed with Minnesota Municipal Commission, the County Auditor of Lac qui Parle County, and the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota, as provided by Rule 16 (a) of Minnesota Municipal Commission Rules of Practice.

Norman Bacon, being duly sworn, on oath, says he is and during all the times herei- stated has been the publisher and printer of the newspaper known as Dawson Sentinel, and has full knowledge of the facts herein stated as follows: (1) Said newspaper is printed in the English language in newspaper format and in column and sheet form equivalent in printed space to at least 900 square inches. (2) Said newspaper is a weekly and is distributed at least once each week. (3) Said newspaper has 50% of its news columns devoted to news of local interest to the community which it purports to serve and does not wholly duplicate any other publication and is not made up entirely of patents, plate matter and advertisements. (4) Said newspaper is circulated in and near the municipality which it purports to serve, has at least 500 copies regularly delivered to paying subscribers, has an average of at least 75% of its total circulation currently paid or no more than three months in arrears and has entry as second-class matter in its local post-office. (5) Said newspaper purports to serve the City of Dawson in the County of Lac qui Parle and it has its known office of issue in the City of Dawson in said county, established and open during its regular business hours for the gathering of news, sale of advertisements and sale of subscriptions and maintained by publisher of said newspaper or persons in his employ and subject to his direction and control during all such regular business hours and at which said newspaper is printed (6) Said newspaper files a copy of each issue immediately with the State Historical Society. (7) Said newspaper has complied with all the foregoing conditions for at least two years preceding the day or dates of publication mentioned below. (8) Said newspaper has filed with the Secretary of State of Minnesota prior to January 1, 1966, and each January 1 thereafter an affidavit in the form prescribed by the Secretary of State and signed by the publisher of newspaper, and sworn to before a notary public stating that the newspaper is a legal newspaper.

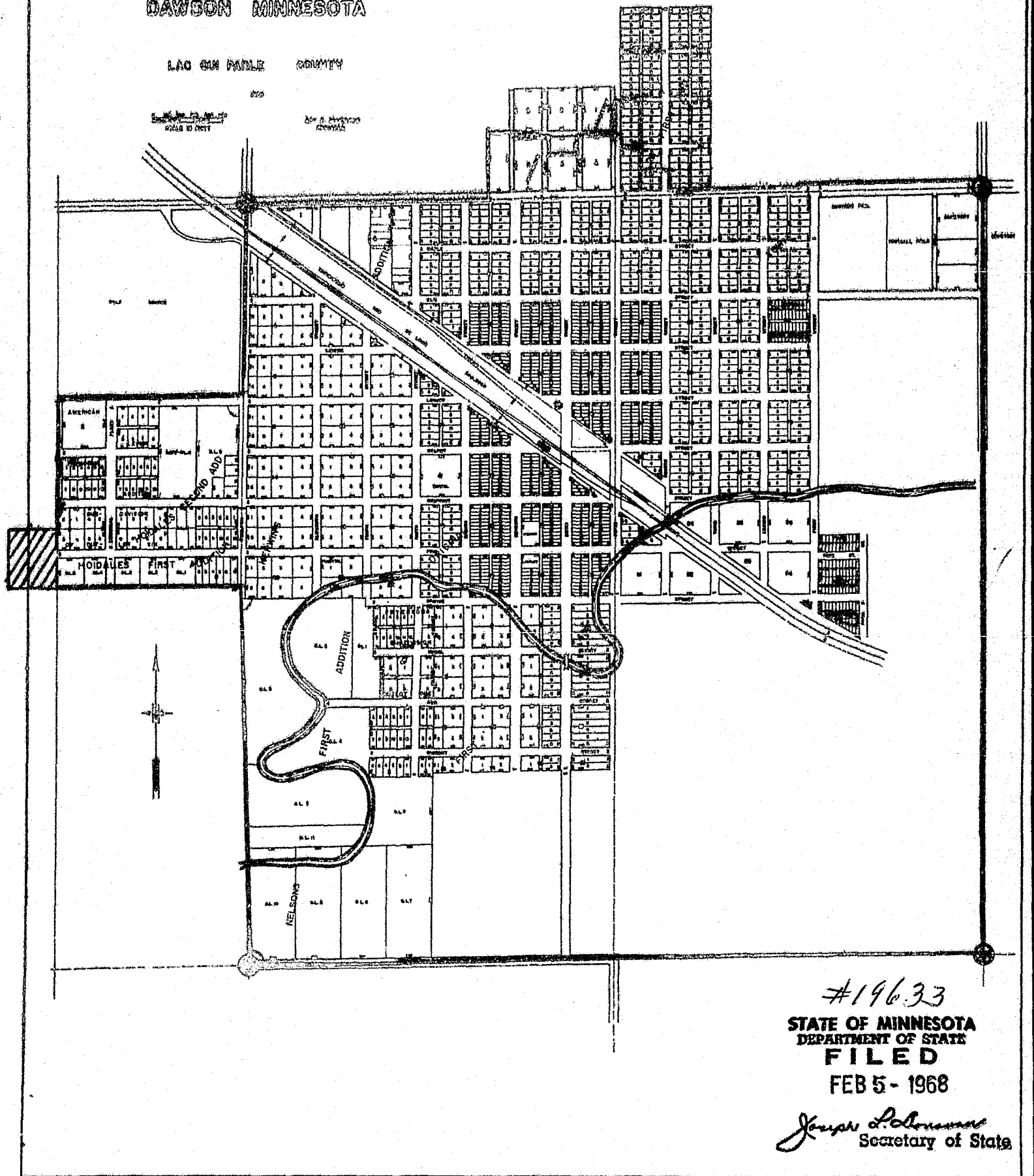

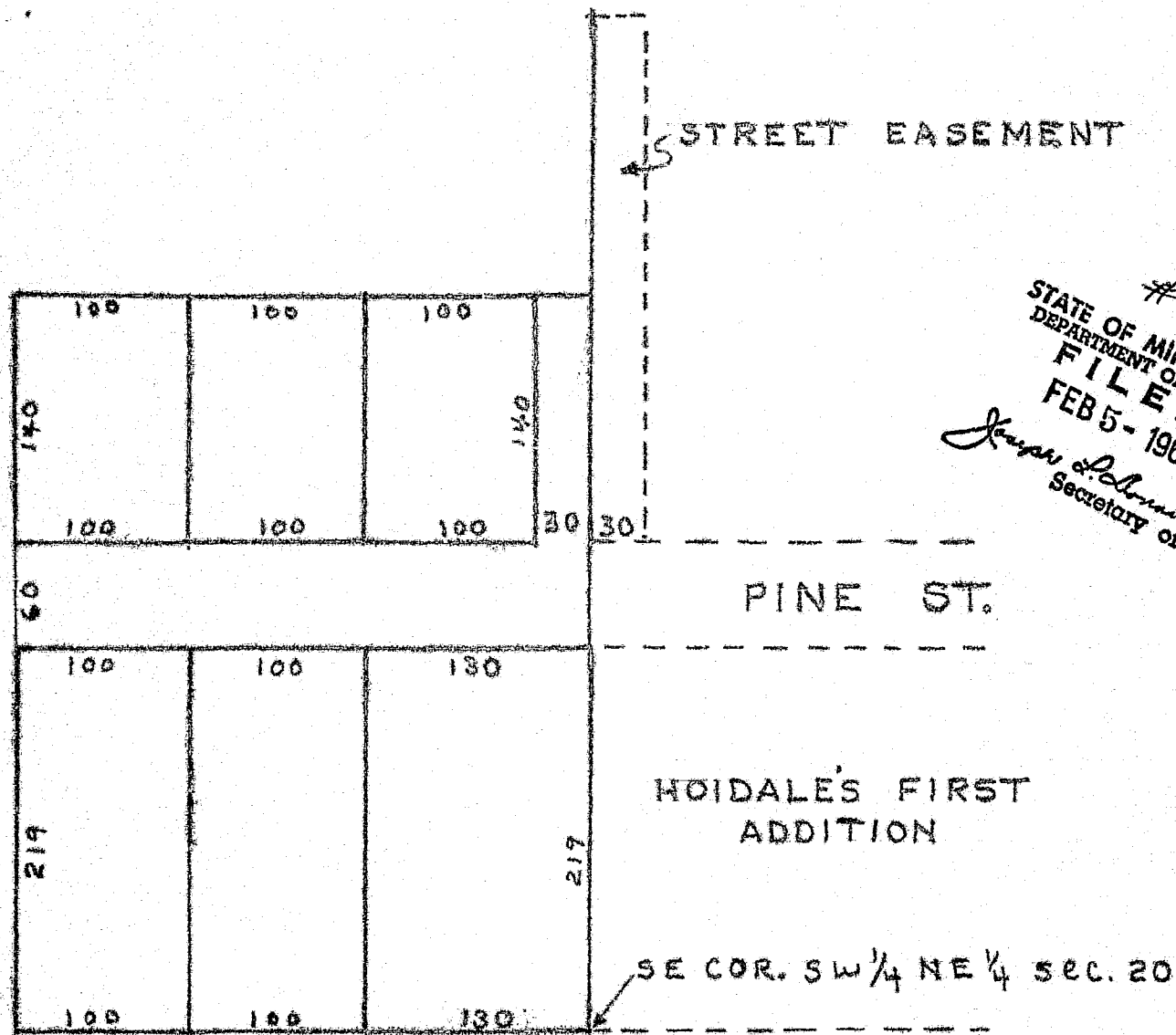
