

Ordinance No. 123

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TERRITORY AND EXTENDING CITY LIMITS.

The City Council of the City of Dawson, Minnesota, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. That it is hereby found and determined that that tract of land situated in Lac qui Parle County, Minnesota described as follows: to-wit:

Beginning in the southwest corner of the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Sixteen (16), in Township One Hundred Seventeen North (117 N), of Range Forty-Three West (43 W) running thence North Fifty (50) feet, running thence East and parallel with the south section line of said section One Thousand Three Hundred Thirty and seven-tenths (1330.7) feet to a point of beginning; running thence North at right angles four hundred twenty-three (423) feet; running thence East at right angles one hundred seventeen and three-tenths (117.3) feet; running thence South four hundred twenty-three (423) feet; running thence West one hundred seventeen and three-tenths (117.3) feet to the point of beginning, abuts the northerly city limits of the City of Dawson and is so situated and conditioned as to be the proper subject of urban government, and that it is to the best interests of the City of Dawson and of said above described territory that it be annexed to the City of Dawson for all governmental purposes.

Section 2. That it is also hereby found and determined that the petition of the sole owner of the above described territory, praying for such annexation was duly filed with the City of Dawson, the Town of Riverside, and the County of Lac qui Parle, on October 25th, 1967, and with Minnesota Municipal Commission on October 26th, 1967, pursuant to the provisions of Section 414.03 Minnesota Statutes Annotated, and that no objections thereto have been presented or filed.

Section 3. That all of said tract described in Section 1 hereof, together with that part of Trunk Highway No. 212 adjacent thereto, is hereby annexed to the City of Dawson for all governmental purposes and that the City limits of the City of Dawson are hereby extended and enlarged to include the same, and that all thereof is hereby zoned as industrial property, and is assigned to and made a part of the Second Ward of the City of Dawson.

Section 4. That this ordinance shall be in effect from and after final passage and publication and that true and correct copies thereof shall be forwarded to and filed with Minnesota Municipal Commission, the County Auditor of Lac qui Parle County, Minnesota and the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota, as provided by Rule 16 (a) of Minnesota Municipal Commission Rules of Practice.

Norman Bacon, being duly sworn, on oath, says he is and during all the times hereof: stated has been the publisher and printer of the newspaper known as Dawson Sentinel, and has full knowledge of the facts herein stated as follows: (1) Said newspaper is printed in the English language in newspaper format and in column and sheet form equivalent in printed space to at least 900 square inches. (2) Said newspaper is a weekly and is distributed at least once each week. (3) Said newspaper has 50% of its news columns devoted to news of local interest to the community which it purports to serve and does not wholly duplicate any other publication and is not made up entirely of patents, plate matter and advertisements. (4) Said newspaper is circulated in and near the municipality which it purports to serve, has at least 500 copies regularly delivered to paying subscribers, has an average of at least 75% of its total circulation currently paid or no more than three months in arrears and has entry as second-class matter in its local post-office. (5) Said newspaper purports to serve the City of Dawson in the County of Lac qui Parle and it has its known office of issue in the City of Dawson in said county, established and open during its regular business hours for the gathering of news, sale of advertisements and sale of subscriptions and maintained by publisher of said newspaper or persons in his employ and subject to his direction and control during all such regular business hours and at which said newspaper is printed (6) Said newspaper files a copy of each issue immediately with the State Historical Society. (7) Said newspaper has complied with all the foregoing conditions for at least two years preceding the day or dates of publication mentioned below. (8) Said newspaper has filed with the Secretary of State of Minnesota prior to January 1, 1966, and each January 1 thereafter an affidavit in the form prescribed by the Secretary of State and signed by the publisher of newspaper, and sworn to before a notary public stating that the newspaper is a legal newspaper.

He further states on oath that the printed Ordinance No. 123 An Ordinance annexing territory and extending city limits hereto attached as a part hereof was cut from the columns of said newspaper, and was printed and published therein in the English language, once each week, for ONE successive weeks; that it was so published on Thursday the 14th day of December, 1967 and was thereafter printed and published on every Thursday to and including the 19th day of December, 1967 and that the following is a printed copy of the lower case alphabet from A to Z, both inclusive, and is hereby acknowledged as being the size and kind of type used in the composition and publication of said notice, to-wit:

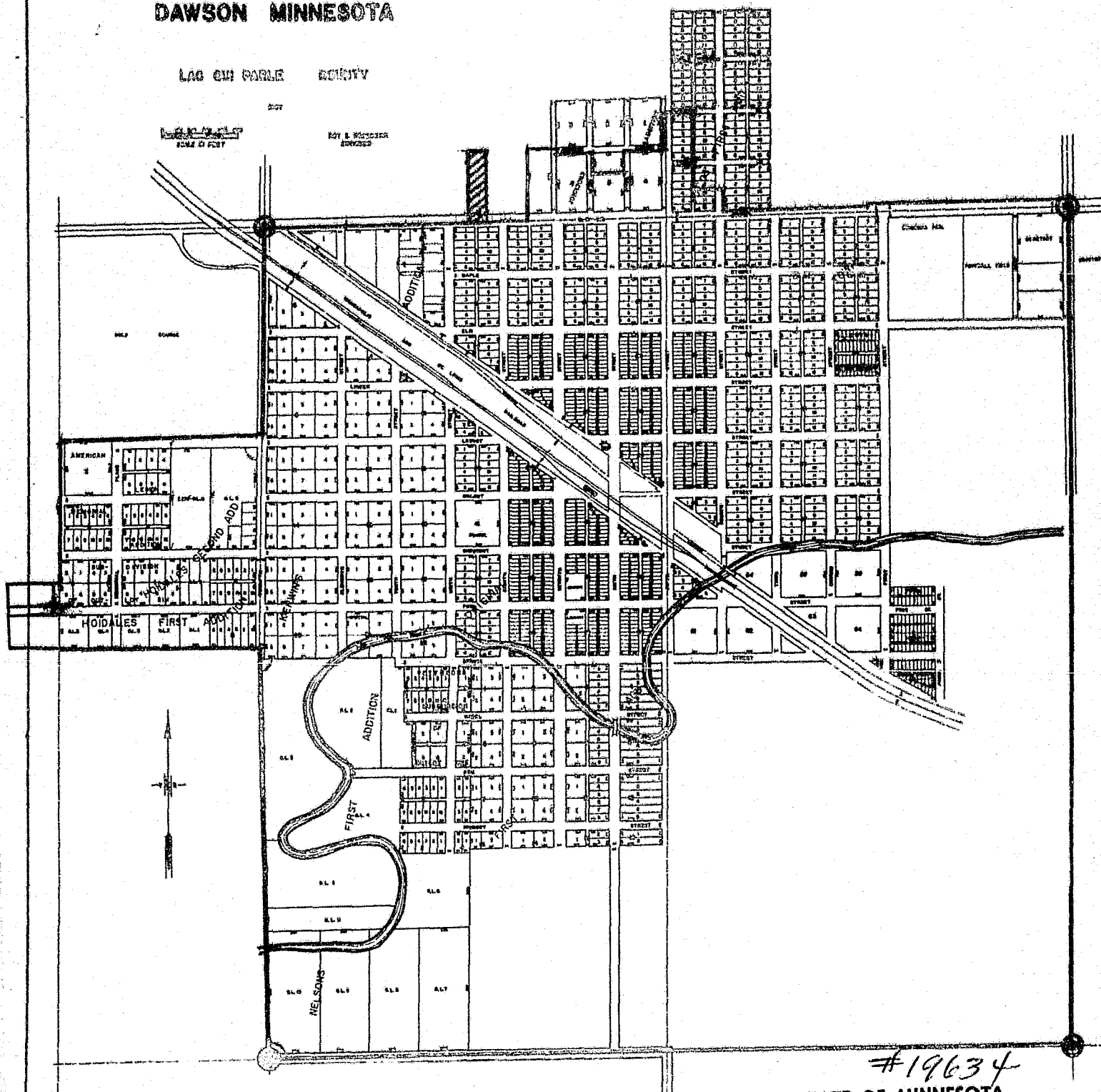
