L. A. Dare, being duly sworn on oath says; that he is, and during
all the times herein stated has been the publisher, editor of the newspaper
known as The Sherburne County Star News, and has full knowledge of the
facts hereinafter stated; that for more than one year prior to the publication
therein of the Ordinance No 46

hereinafter described, said
newspaper was printed and published in the Village of Elk River, in the
County of Sherburne, State of Minnesota, on Thursday of each week; that
during all said time said newspaper has been printed in the English language
from its known office of publication within the village from which it purports
to be issued as above stated and in newspaper format and in column and
sheet form equivalent in space to at least 450 running inches of single
column, two inches wide; has been issued once each week from a known
office established in said place of publication and employing skilled workmen
and the necessary material for preparing and printing the same; that the
press work on that part of the newspaper devoted to local news of interest

near its said place of publication to the extent of at least two hundred and
forty (240) copies regularly delivered to paying subscribers and has entry
as second class matter in its local post office; that there has been on file
in the office of the County Auditor of Sherburne County, Minnesota, the
affidavit of a person having knowledge of the facts, showing the name and
location of said newspaper and the existence of the conditions constituting its
qualifications as a legal newspaper; and that a copy of each issue has been
filed with the State Historical Society.

That the Ordinance No 46

Dear Mrs. Looney:

The secretary of state has received from the hand of the state auditor your letter dated January 15, 1968 together with a copy of Ordinance No. 46 changing the name of Lake Fremont to Zimmerman, together with Printer's Affidavit of Publication.

We do not wish to be technical, but respectfully suggest that you review the language of Minnesota Statutes Section 413.02, Subdivisions 3 and 4, and for legal safety make sure you have complied in every detail.

Subd. 3: "The name of any village in this state may be changed to the same name as the postoffice therein, by an ordinance of the village so declaring, duly and legally adopted by the council thereof, when the name of the village is different from the name of the postoffice therein as designated by the United States postal authorities."

Subd. 4: When effective. "Upon the filing of a certified copy of such ordinance with the auditor of the county in which the village is located, and with the state auditor and the secretary of state, the name of the village shall be changed as in such ordinance provided...."

We will hold your communication for our information and that of the state auditor, but we urgently suggest that you prepare three copies, certified by you as true and correct with your seal of office, and promptly forward one copy to each officer named in Subdivision 4. It is probable that the name of your village is not legally changed until this has been done.
