WHEREAS, Minnesota ranks fifth in the nation in spring pigs saved, and second in the nation in number of hogs slaughtered, and

WHEREAS, Minnesota swine producers have a constant program of improving the quality of animals for consumer satisfaction, and

WHEREAS, the wide variety of nutritious and tasty pork products makes it ideal for menu planning and contributes a great deal to the health of our citizens,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold LeVander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of January 16-23, 1968, as

"STATE PORK WEEK"

in Minnesota, and urge the purchase of the wide selection of delicious pork products, bacon, chops, ham, spareribs, roasts, sausage for enjoyment in good eating.
