PROCLAMATION

- WHEREAS, there are 1,800 public and private schools participating in the School Lunch Program in Minnesota, and
- WHEREAS, there are 495,000 school children who enjoy 1/3 of their daily nutritional requirements derived from this program, and
- WHEREAS, Minnesota schools purchased locally \$17.5 million of food products during the 1967 school year, and
- WHEREAS, agriculture contributes a major part of the State's economy, and it is important that our schools endeavor at all times to serve Minnesota foods, and
- WHEREAS, it is fitting we salute our Agricultural Industry and our School Lunch Program in Minnesota,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold Levander, Governor of the State of Minnesota do hereby proclaim the week of January 22-26, 1968, as

"ALL MINNESOTA FOODS WEEK IN ALL MINNESOTA SCHOOLS"

and urge all schools of this State to participate in serving a complete menu of foods produced and processed in Minnesota.
