- WHEREAS, engineering is the profession in which scientific knowledge is applied with judgment to develop ways to utilize economically, the materials and forces of nature for the benefit of mankind, and
- WHEREAS, the engineering profession has contributed materially to the growth and development of industry, transportation, and communications in the great Northwest, and
- WHEREAS, we recognize in our progressive State the need for stimulating continued enthusiasm for engineering among our young people in order to satisfy the growing demand for engineering services in industry, government, and private practice,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold LeVander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim February 18-24, 1968, as

"NATIONAL ENGINEERS' WEEK"

in Minnesota, and urge the citizens of this great State to salute with me those professional men who create engineering design for tomorrow.
