MINUTES OF SPECIAL ELECTION.

AT THE SPECIAL ELECTION OF THE VILLAGE OF BOWLUS IN THE COUNTY OF MORRISON AND STATE OF MINNESOTA, HELD AT THE ENGINE HOUSE BEING THE PLACE WHERE IT WAS DIRECTED TO BE HELD BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL AFTER GIVING DUE NOTICE THEREOF AS PROVIDED BY LAW; ON THE 4TH DAY OF FEBRUARY A. D. 1919 THEO. PIERZINA AND VINCENT SCHWIENK TWO QUALIFIED VOTERS OF SAID VILLAGE, TO ACT AS JUDGES OF SUCH SPECIAL ELECTION AND ONE QUALIFIED VOTER OF SAID VILLAGE TO ACT AS CLERK OF SUCH SPECIAL ELECTION, EACH OF WHOM HAD WITHIN TEN DAYS BEFORE SUCH TIME BEEN DESIGNATED AND APPOINTED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL TO ACT AS JUDGES AND CLERK RESPECTIVELY OF SUCH SPECIAL ELECTION THE ELECTORS PRESENT AT THE TIME AND PLACE NAMED FOR OPENING THE POLLS ELECTED ONE JUDGE V. SCHWIENK, BECAUSE THE PERSON SO APPOINTED REFUSED TO SERVE WHO, BEING PRESENT, AT THE HOUR OF 9 O'CLOCK A. M., EACH OF THEM DULY TOOK AND SUBSCRIBED AN OATH _____ TO FAITHFULLY DISCHARGE THE DUTIES REQUIRED OF THEM AT SUCH ELECTION, AND THE SAID JUDGES AND CLERK BEING DULY QUALIFIED, FORTHWITH OPENED THE POLLS BY PROCLAMATION, AND THE ELECTION PROCEEDED BY BALLOT WITHOUT ADJOURNMENT OR INTERMISSION UNTIL CLOSED.

THE SUBJECTS VOTED ON AT SUCH SPECIAL ELECTION, AS STATED IN THE NOTICE THEREOF, WERE;

SHOULD THE VILLAGE OF BOWLUS BE SEPARATED FROM THE TOWN OF TWO RIVERS FOR ASSESSMENT AND ELECTION PURPOSES AND BECOME A SEPARATE ELECTION AND ASSESSMENT DISTRICT? YES OR NO.

AT 5 O'CLOCK IN THE AFTERNOON OF SAID DAY THE POLLS WERE CLOSED, PROCLAMATION THEREOF HAVING BEEN MADE BY ONE OF THE JUDGES THIRTY MINUTES PREVIOUS THERETO. THE JUDGES AND CLERK THEN PROCEEDED FORTHWITH TO PUBLICLY COUNT THE VOTES CAST, AND THE RESULT THEREOF WAS DULY PROCLAIMED TO THE VOTERS BY SAID JUDGES AND CLERK, WHO RECORDED THE SAME IN THE VILLAGE MINUTE BOOK.

WE, THE UNDERSIGNED, MEMBERS OF THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BOWLUS, MORRISON COUNTY, MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY CERTIFY TO YOU, IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 1238, G. S. 1913, AS FOLLOWS:

THAT ON THE 15TH DAY OF FEBRUARY, 1919 A SPECIAL ELECTION WAS DULY HELD IN THE SAID VILLAGE OF BOWLUS, FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF THE SAID VILLAGE, THE FOLLOWING QUESTION: "SHALL THE VILLAGE OF BOWLUS BE SEPARATED FROM THE TOWN OF TWO RIVERS FOR THE ASSESSMENT AND ELECTION PURPOSES AND BECOME A SEPARATE ELECTION AND ASSESSMENT DISTRICT." THAT SAID SPECIAL ELECTION WAS DULY CALLED AND HELD, AND THAT THE NUMBERS OF VOTES CAST AT SAID ELECTION ON THE SAID QUESTION WAS 48, AS FOLLOWS: FOR THE SAID SEPARATION AND IN FAVOR THEREOF: 48; AGAINST NONE.

THAT THE JUDGES OF THE SAID SPECIAL ELECTION HAVE DULY CERTIFIED THE FOREGOING FACTS TO THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE SAID VILLAGE, AS PROVIDED BY STATUTE, AND THAT THE SAID COUNCIL HEREBY CERTIFIES THE RESULT OF THE SAID ELECTION TO YOU, AS PROVIDED BY LAW.
