

ORDINANCE NUMBER 20.

An ordinance changing the name of the village heretofore incorporated and known as the Village of New Germany from New Germany to Motordale.

The village council of the Village of New Germany, Carver County, Minnesota, do ordain as follows:

Section 1. The name of the postoffice in this village having been heretofore designated and being now fixed by the United States postal authorities as Motordale, the name of this village is hereby changed from New Germany to Motordale, pursuant to the provisions of Section 1273, General Statutes of 1913.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage, approval and publication.
