I hereby resign as Judge of Municipal Court of the City of East Grand Forks, Minnesota, effective at 12:01 o'clock A.M., January 1, 1968.

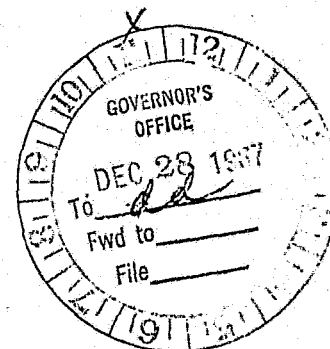

Gov. Harold LeVander has appointed Theodore F. Giese, East Grand Forks attorney, as Municipal Judge in that community, it was announced Wednesday.

The appointment became effective January 8, according to the Governor. Giese replaces Judge Robert L. Stewart who retired January 1.

Giese has practiced law in East Grand Forks since 1938 with the exception of service in the U. S. Army during World War II.

He graduated from the University of Minnesota Law School in 1936 and previously obtained his B.S. degree from the University of North Dakota.

He is a member of the East Grand Forks Chamber of Commerce and local and state bar associations.

Born and raised in East Grand Forks, Giese resides at 1313 N. 5th St.
