On December 18th. 1967, I made a verbal request to you for my resignation as Probate-Juvenile Judge of Benton County. To which you advised me that you would give consideration.

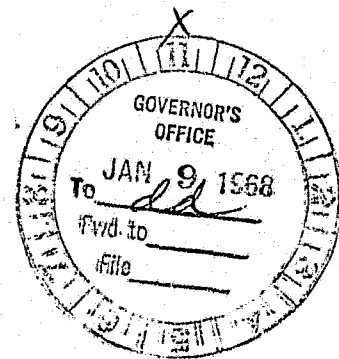
As of this date I am herewith making the same request to you in writing to take effect Feb. 1st. 1968.
