

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS  
OF THE VILLAGE OF LESTER PRAIRIE TO INCLUDE  
UNINCORPORATED PLATTED LAND ADJUTTING UPON  
THE VILLAGE LIMITS.

WHEREAS, a certain petition dated July 24, 1967,  
requesting annexation of the territory hereinafter described  
was duly presented to the council on the 3 day of  
October, 1967, and,

WHEREAS, the Quantity of land embraced within the  
area described in the petition and bounded as described is  
half an acre of platted land, no part of which is included  
within the limits of an incorporated city, village, or borough,  
and,

WHEREAS, the petition was signed by all the  
owners, and,

WHEREAS, no objection to the annexation has been  
received from the town board, the county board, or the governing  
body of any municipality whose boundaries abut upon the bound-  
aries of the land to be annexed, and,

WHEREAS, the land described in the petition abuts  
upon the village limits at the West and Southerly boundaries  
thereof;

The council of the Village of Lester Prairie,  
Minnesota, ordains:

Section 1. The village council hereby determines  
that the annexation will be to the best interests of the village  
and of the territory affected; (2) that the territory described  
herein abuts upon the village limits and is urban or suburban  
in character; and (3) that none of said territory is now in-  
cluded within the limits of any city, village, or borough.

Section 2. Territory Annexed. The corporate

limits of the village are hereby extended to include the plat-  
ted land described as follows and the same is hereby annexed to  
and included within the village as effectually as if it had ori-  
ginally been a part thereof:

Commencing at the West Quarter corner of Section  
2, Township 116 North of Range 27 West; thence  
South 0° 00' along the West line of said Section  
2 for 672.7 feet to the extended center line of  
First Avenue South in the Village of Lester  
Prairie, Minnesota, said point being the point  
of beginning; thence continuing South 0° 00'  
for 355.0 feet; thence 589.35° East for 623.25  
feet; thence North 0° 11' West for 325.0 feet  
to the South line of said First Avenue South;  
thence North 89° 30' West along said South line  
of First Avenue South for 30.0 feet; thence  
North 0° 11' West for 30.0 feet to the center-  
line of said First Avenue South; thence North  
89° 30' West along the extended center line of  
said First Avenue South for 792.0 feet to the  
point of beginning, McLeod County, Minnesota.

Section 3. Filing. The village clerk is hereby

directed to file certified copies of this Ordinance with the  
Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Secretary of State, and  
the County Auditor.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance takes

effect upon its passage and publication and the filing of the  
certified copies as directed in Section 3.
