ORDINANCE NO. 47A

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS
OF THE VILLAGE OF LESTER PRAIRIE TO INCLUDE
UNINCORPORATED AND UNPLATTED LAND ADJACENT
UPON THE VILLAGE LIMITS.

WHEREAS, a certain petition dated August 23, 1967,
requesting the annexation of the territory hereinafter described
was duly presented to the council on the 6 day of
February, 1968, and,

WHEREAS, the quantity of land embraced within the area
described in the petition and bounded as described, is less
than three acres of unplatted land, no part of which is included
within the limits of an incorporated city, village, or borough,
and,

WHEREAS, the petition was signed by all the owners, and,

WHEREAS, no objection to the annexation has been re-
ceived from the town board, the county board, or the governing
body of any municipality whose boundaries abut upon the bound-
aries of the land to be annexed, and,

WHEREAS, the land described in the petition abuts upon
the village limits at the northerly and Easterly boundaries
thereof;

The council of the Village of Lester Prairie, Minnesota,
enacts:

Section 1. The village council hereby determines that
the annexation will be to the best interests of the village
and of the territory affected; (2) that the territory described
herein abuts upon the village limits and is urban or suburban
in character and (3) that none of said territory is now in-
cluded within the limits of any city, village, or borough.

Section 2. Territory annexed. The corporate limits

of the village are hereby extended to include the unplatted land described as follows and the same is hereby annexed to and included within the village as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof;

Beginning at the Southwest corner of St. Peter Evangelical Lutheran Church Addition; thence South 0°00' for 120 feet along the west line of Section 2, Township 116 North, Range 27 West of the 5th P.M, thence North 89° 27' east for 824.35 feet; thence North 0°11' West along the west line of Schultz's 1st Add. for 120 feet; thence North 89° 35' west for 823.24 feet along the south line of Second Avenue South to the point of beginning; and also that area known and platted as Schultz's Add. in the southwest Quarter of Section 2, Township 116 N. Range 27 West.

Section 3. Filing. The Village Clerk of Lester Prairie, Minnesota, is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Secretary of State, and the County Auditor.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication and the filing of the certified copies so directed in Section 3.



WHEREAS, no objection to the annexation has been re-
