AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF LESTER PRAIRIE TO INCLUDE UNITEGRATED AND UNPLATTED LAND ABUTTING UPON THE VILLAGE LIMITS.

THEREAS, a cortain polition dated August 23, 1967, requesting the appointed of the torritory hereinafter described was duly presented to the council on the 6 day of February 19 68, and,

WHENEAS, the quantity of land cobraced within the area described in the potition and bounded as described, is less than three acres of unplotted land, no part of which is included within the limits of an incorporated city, willage, or borough, and,

WHEREAS, the petition was signed by all the ceners, and, unexact, no objection to the annexation has been received from the town board, the county board, or the governing body of any unnicipality whose boundaries abut upon the boundaries of the land to be annexed, and,

WHEREAS, the land described in the petition abuts upon the village limits of the mortherly and Easterly boundaries thoroof;

Scation 1.
