
Dear Mr. Mannion:



ORDINANCE NO. 371

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF MARSHALL  
TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNPLATTED LAND NOT EXCEEDING TWO HUNDRED ACRES.

The Common Council of the City of Marshall do ordain as follows:

Section 1. A petition has been filed with the Common Council of  
the City of Marshall, Minnesota by all the owners of the following  
described real estate in the County of Lyon, State of Minnesota, to  
have such land included within the City of Marshall, Minnesota:

All that part of the Northwest Quarter ( $NW\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Thirty-three (33), Township One Hundred Twelve (112), Range Forty-one (41), lying west of the right-of-way of the Willmar and Sioux Falls Railroad Company in Lyon County, Minnesota.

All that part of the Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter ( $NW\frac{1}{4}$   $NE\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Thirty-three (33), Township One Hundred Twelve (112), Range Forty-one (41) lying north and west of right-of-way of the Willmar and Sioux Falls Railroad Company in Lyon County, Minnesota.

Save and except the following parcels:

1. The north ten (10) acres of the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter ( $NW\frac{1}{4}$   $NW\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Thirty-three (33), Township One Hundred Twelve (112), Range Forty-one (41).
2. All that part of the North Half ( $N\frac{1}{2}$ ) of Section Thirty-three (33), Township One Hundred Twelve (112), Range Forty-one (41), described as follows: Beginning at a point where the north section line of said Section 33 intersects the northwesterly right-of-way line of the Willmar and Sioux Falls Railroad located and constructed through said Section 33, thence southwesterly along said right-of-way line on an assumed bearing of south 19 degrees 50 minutes west 363.1 feet, thence north 39 degrees 48 minutes west 1311.1 feet, thence north 0 degrees 01 minutes east 331 feet, thence north 89 degrees 44 minutes east 1637 feet to point of beginning, containing 11.54 acres, more or less.
3. All that part of the Northwest Quarter ( $NW\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Thirty-three (33), Township One Hundred Twelve (112), Range Forty-one (41), described as follows: Commencing at a point 1317 feet south of the Northwest corner of said Northwest Quarter ( $NW\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Thirty-three (33) and running thence north along said section line, a distance of 240 feet, thence east at right angles, a distance of 300 feet; thence south at right angles, a distance of 240 feet; thence west at right angles a distance of 300 feet to point of beginning.
4. All that part of the Northwest Quarter ( $NW\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Thirty-three (33), Township One Hundred Twelve (112), Range Forty-one (41), described as follows: Beginning

at a point on the easterly boundary of the right-of-way of U. S. Highway No. 59 distant 75.0 feet east and 265.0 feet north of the west quarter corner of Section 33, Township 112, Range 41, thence in a northerly direction along said easterly boundary of said right-of-way line a distance of 50.0 feet; thence in an easterly direction parallel to the quarter line a distance of 1042.1 feet to the westerly boundary of the Willmar and Sloux Falls Railway right-of-way; thence in a southwesterly direction along said westerly boundary of the railway right-of-way a distance of 351.7 feet to a point on said quarter line; thence in a westerly direction along said quarter line a distance of 700 feet; thence in a northerly direction parallel with the easterly boundary of the highway right-of-way a distance of 100.0 feet; thence in a westerly direction parallel to said quarter line a distance of 1026.4 feet to the place of beginning.

5. All that part of the Northeast Quarter (NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>) of Section Thirty-three (33), Township One Hundred Twelve (112), Range Forty-one (41), described as follows: Beginning at a point on the southerly line of said quarter section 1103.4 feet east of the west quarter corner; thence in a northerly direction parallel with the easterly boundary of the right-of-way of U. S. Highway No. 59, a distance of 265 feet; thence in a westerly direction parallel with the southerly line of said quarter section a distance of 164 feet; thence in a southerly direction parallel with the easterly line of said highway right-of-way a distance of 265 feet to the southerly line of said quarter section; thence in an easterly direction along the southerly line of said quarter section a distance of 164 feet to the place of beginning.

6. All that part of the Northwest Quarter (NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>) of Section Thirty-three (33), Township One Hundred Twelve (112), Range Forty-one (41), described as follows: The south 72.5 feet of the west 300 feet of the Northwest Quarter (NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>) of Section 32, Township 112, Range 41, containing about one-half acre more or less.

7. All that part of the Northwest Quarter (NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>) of Section Thirty-three (33), Township One Hundred Twelve (112), Range Forty-one (41), described as follows: Commencing at a point on the westerly line of the Northwest Quarter (NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>) of Section 33, Township 112, Range 41, 1077 feet south of the Northwest corner of said Section 33 and running thence north along said section line, a distance of 475 feet; thence east at right angles, a distance of 565 feet; thence south at right angles a distance of 475 feet; thence west at right angles a distance of 565 feet to the point of beginning.

8. All that part of the Northwest Quarter (NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>) of Section Thirty-three (33), Township One Hundred Twelve (112), Range Forty-one (41), described as follows: Beginning at a point on the southerly line of said quarter section 939.4 feet east of the west quarter corner; thence in a northerly direction parallel with the easterly boundary of the right-of-way of U. S. Highway No. 59, a distance of 265 feet; thence in a westerly direction parallel with the southerly line of said quarter section a distance of 164 feet; thence in a southerly direction parallel with the easterly line of said highway right-of-way a distance of 265 feet to the southerly line of said quarter section; thence in an easterly direction along the southerly line of said quarter section a distance of 164 feet to the point of beginning.

Section 2. The quantity of land embraced within the foregoing description and bounded as described, is 101.70 acres, more or less.

Section 3. The Common Council hereby determines (1) that the annexation will be to the best interests of the City of Marshall, Minnesota and of the territory affected; and (2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the City and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to City government.

Section 4. Therefore, the City of Marshall, Minnesota hereby ordains and declares that the property hereinafore described be and the same is hereby annexed to, and included in, the City of Marshall, Minnesota, as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

Section 5. This ordinance shall be final and shall take effect and be in force from and after filing certified copy thereof with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the County Auditor and the Secretary of State, and from and after its passage and publication.
