




TO THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF THIEF RIVER FALLS:

Your petitioners respectfully represent: That petitioners are the owners in fee of the following described premises situated in the County of Pennington and State of Minnesota, to-wit:


Lots Ten (10), Eleven (11) and Twelve (12) in Garden Addition to Fairfield, according to the plat on file in the office of the Register of Deeds.

That said territory adjoins upon the incorporated property of the City of Thief River Falls; that said territory is platted; that said territory is bounded on the south by the south line of Thirteenth Street, on the east by the centerline of Main Avenue, on the north by the north line of Lot Ten (10) extended to the centerline of Main Avenue, on the west by the west line of said Lots Ten (10), Eleven (11) and Twelve (12) extended to the south line of Thirteenth Street; that the quantity of land embraced within these boundaries is less than 25 acres; that the number of actual residents in said tract is zero; that there are two buildings located upon said tract, one of which is a lumber yard office and the other which is a lumber yard shed; that said territory is not now served by city streets, city sewage disposal, city water, fire or police protection; that said territory is located in the Town of North, County of Pennington; that the boundary of no other municipality abuts upon the boundaries of the land to be annexed.

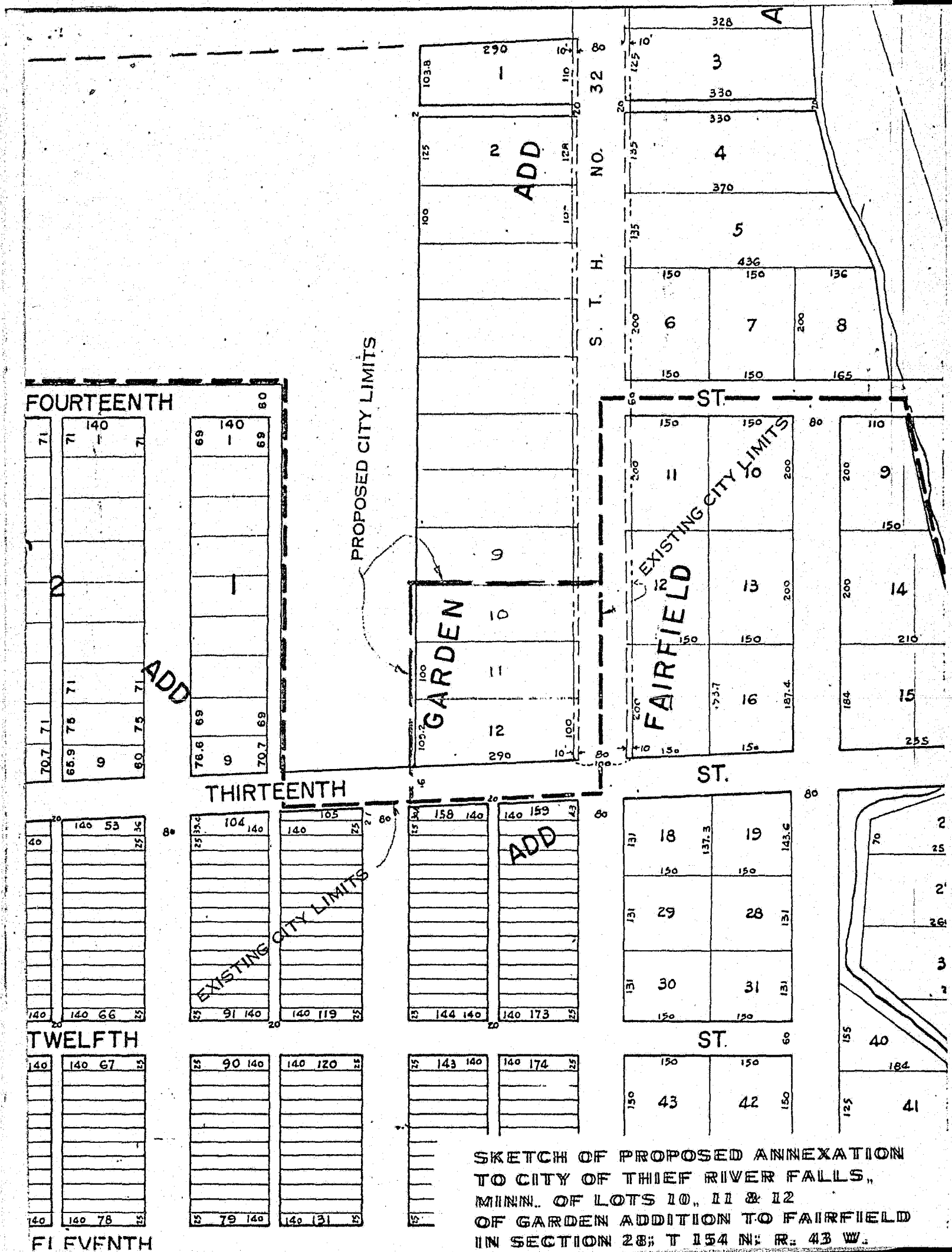

RESOLUTION
NO. 12-262-67

At a regular meeting of the City Council held December 12, 1967 Alderman Wysoski, seconded by Alderman Narverud introduced the following resolution and moved its adoption:

ORDINANCE NO. 330
AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN LANDS
TO THE CITY OF THIEF RIVER FALLS.

The City Council of the City of Thief River Falls do hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1.

WHEREAS the sole owners of the following described premises situated in the County of Pennington and State of Minnesota, to-wit:

Lots Ten (10), Eleven (11) and Twelve (12) of Garden Addition to Fairfield,

have petitioned the City Council to have such lands included within the municipality and have filed copies of said petition with the Municipal Commission of the State of Minnesota, with the Town Board of North, County of Pennington and with the County Board of the County of Pennington, State of Minnesota, and

WHEREAS the above described property abuts upon the boundaries of the City of Thief River Falls, and

WHEREAS no objection to the proposed annexation has been submitted,

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby determined that the annexation of said premises would be to the best interest of the City of Thief River Falls and of the territory affected and the above described premises are hereby declared annexed to the City of Thief River Falls.

Section 2.

This Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage, approval, publication and filing with the Municipal Commission, the Pennington County Auditor and the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota.
