> ORDINANCE NO. 330 AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN LANDS TO THE CITY OF THIEF RIVER FALLS.

The City Council of the City of Thief River Falls do hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1.

WHEREAS the sole owners of the following described premises situated in the County of Pennington and State of Minnesota, to-wit:

Lots Ten (10), Eleven (11) and Twelve (12) of Garden Addition to Fairfield,

have petitioned the 'City Council to have such lands included within the municipality and have filed copies of said petition with the Municipal Commission of the State of Minnesota, with the Town Board of North, County of Pennington and with the County Board of the County of Pennington, State of Minnesota, and

WHEREAS the above described property abuts upon the boundaries of the City of Thief River Falls, and

WHEREAS no objection to the proposed annexation has been submitted,

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby determined that the annexation of said premises would be to the best interest of the City of Thief River Falls and of the territory affected and the above described premises are hereby declared annexed to the City of Thief River Falls.

Section 2.

This Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage, approval, publication and filing with the Municipal Commission, the Pennington County Auditor and the Secretary of State of the State of-Minnesota.
