PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF NORTHFIELD, MINN.

1st. That said City Charter be amended by adding to Section 4 of Chapter 5 thereof, the following:

"And it may levy a special tax for the maintenance of a City Hospital not to exceed three twentieths of one percent of the assessed valuation in any year."

2nd. That said City Charter be amended by adding to Chapter 11 thereof a section as follows:

"Section $7\frac{1}{6}$: If a city hospital shall be established the management and control thereof shall be vested in a board of five (5) directors, to be appointed by the mayor with the approval of the City Council. One member shall hold office for one year, one for two years, one for three years, one for four years and one for five years; and annually thereafter the mayor shall appoint one director for the term of five years. No practicing physician shall be a director and no director shall receive compensation as such."
