WHEREAS, DR. MARTIN LUTHER KING, NOBEL PEACE PRIZE WINNER AND ADVOCATE OF NON-VIOLENCE AND WAS HIMSELF A VICTEM OF VIOLENCE AND PASSED AWAY YESTERDAY, AND

WHEREAS, DR. MARTIN LUTHER KING WAS A LEADER IN PROCLAIMING THE FREEDOM AND EQUALITY OF ALL MEN AND DISTINQUISHED HIMSELF IN SERVICE TO HIS RACE AND TO ALL PEOPLE OF THE UNITED STATES, NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AS A SYMBOL OF SYMPATHY AND MOURNING FROM THE PEOPLE OF MINNESOTA THE STATE FLAG FLYING OVER THE STATE CAPITOL SHALL BE LOWERED TO HALF MAST.
